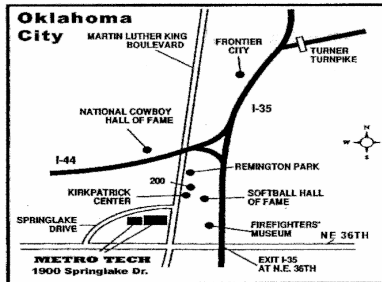
## education credit
