## Emergency Preparedness

Natural and man-made disasters directly impact senior residences and long-term care communities. This webinar series is designed to equip senior living and long-term care professionals with the core competencies of preparing a disaster plan, properly implementing the plan, and returning to normalcy after a disaster.

### Webinar 1: Getting Ready

Explores the core competencies needed to prepare your community to respond to any natural or man-made disaster or emergency. This session focuses on:

- key elements of effective disaster preparedness
- preparing your staff and residents for a disaster or emergency
- developing a comprehensive disaster preparedness plan that focuses on the “all-hazards” approach to surveillance, response, mitigation, and recovery

### Webinar 2: Weathering the Storm

The necessary steps to properly implement your disaster plan during an emergency are examined. This session focuses on:

- executing the Incident Command System
- sheltering in place
- implementing an evacuation

### Webinar 3: Putting Your Community Back Together

After weathering the storm, how does your community return to normalcy? This session focuses on:

- providing support and/or interventions to ease the trauma of the disaster or emergency
- evaluating the lessons learned
- updating your disaster plan based on what you learned
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All series participants will receive an Incident Command Template, Vulnerability Assessment Tool and an Emergency Operations Plan Considerations and Guideline.
